

## Veritas in Academia Acknowledged Policies

- Parents of children ages 9 and under **MUST** stay on campus while their children are at VIA. This is necessary because VIA is neither a registered school nor daycare.
- Children ages 9 and under **MUST** be with their parents when not in a class. This means parents must be **WITH** their children when they are in the gym, dining hall, nursery, or on the playground.
- Children in 6-9 year-old classes and younger must be picked up from class by a parent at the end of the class period. The tutor will dismiss the children into their parents care and supervision.
- Upon leaving class, children in 4th-6th grade classes should go directly to the dining hall, returning to their parent's supervision.
- Students in 7th-12th classes should be either in class, study hall, or family study time in the dining hall.
- **ONLY** students, tutors, and parents picking up children from class should be beyond the gate at the top of the ramp. No parents or children should be loitering in the upper hallway. This is out of respect for both classes in session, and the Ss. Peter and Paul Parish Staff.
- Parents **MUST** monitor their children in the gym during open gym periods. Families **MUST** pick up and put away the equipment used. Children **MAY NOT** be in the gym with the lights turned off.
- Per Ss. Peter and Paul Parish Policy, **no children under the age of 18 are allowed in the kitchen.**
- Any children younger than 7th grade may only be at lunch if accompanied by a parent.
- Ss. Peter and Paul kitchen supplies are **NOT** for VIA use. This includes: utensils, plates, napkins, paper cups, and the water cooler located in the kitchen.
- Families and students **MUST** clean up their table and the floor around their table after lunch.
- There is to be no use of electronics by students while in the building, including at lunch. Exceptions may be granted by the onsite monitor.

● All tutors, families, students, and children attending VIA must respect the Ss. Peter and Paul facility. All play a part in maintaining an excellent relationship between VIA and the Ss. Peter and Paul Parish. This means adhering to Parish policies, cleaning up after ourselves, and monitoring children closely.
