## **Class Description:**

The aim of BHC kindergarten is to serve as a student's introduction to co-op classroom learning, as well as to help foster a love of learning at home. It is a precious year where class time is structured around wonderful books. We will use a selection of stories from the Five In A Row curriculum to guide a variety of multisensory activities across multiple subjects. Our history and Bible curriculums aim to lead kindergartners to love and treasure God, as they learn truths about his Word and his world. Each week we will focus on aspects of history, fine and gross motor skills, story elements, art, and Bible, while the children also experience the delight of walking alongside classmates and peers in the co-op community.

## **Curriculum & Supplies:**

- Read-aloud book selections from <u>Five In A Row</u> by Jane Claire Lambert (A complete book list will be sent by the teacher on or before May 1st)
- <u>History for Little Pilgrims</u> by Christian Liberty Press
- Leading Little Ones to God by Marian M. Schoolland

## **Tests, Assignments, & Grades:**

Kindergarten is a wonderful year where we will focus on cementing foundational skills and fostering a love for learning at co-op. Homework assignments will be provided each week and are expected to be completed at home with a parent and on time. Students will keep a binder as a sort of ongoing "portfolio" of their work. Each child will have the opportunity to present an "All About Me" presentation. Kindergartners will not receive a letter grade for this class.
