Class Description:

BHC science classes use a rotation of the God's Design series from Master Books Publishers. This year, we will be studying God's Design for Life- a study in life sciences. The course covers three sections: The World of Plants, The World of Animals, and The Human Body. During the study of the World of Plants, we will learn about the amazing structures of plants. We will study photosynthesis, pollination, carnivorous plants, and much more. We will then change topics to study the Human Body. This anatomy topic will cover the major systems of the body- skeletal, muscular, nervous, digestive, circulatory, and immunity. Finally, we will turn our attention to other creatures living on earth as we focus on the World of Animals. We'll study how animals without backbones move, how birds fly, and how insects change in metamorphosis. The amazing creativity of God will be evident as we see each of His unique living creatures!

Most weeks will follow a similar pattern. Students will be given direct instruction for a portion of the class, and we will spend the remainder experimenting with our topic. They will be given a homework assignment that will reinforce our topic for the week. Most of the homework will be reading from the textbook and reviewing notes from class. With very few exceptions, experiments will be completed during class time.

Tests, Assignments, & Grades:

Students will learn to take tests in a classroom environment. Each grade level will be given an evaluation that is specific to the amount of understanding expected in their grade. One quiz will be given at the end of each unit. At the completion of each subject, a more comprehensive exam will be given in class. Quizzes and exams are given to encourage practice with basic study skills, to evaluate understanding of topics, and to ease the student into comfort with test-taking. Each of the 3 subjects will include a final project. Assignments may include a classroom presentation, a compilation of comprehensive work, or a final classroom activity.
