### **Class Description:**

We will focus on Year 3 of the Tapestry of Grace Curriculum beginning with John Adams' presidency and ending with the Spanish-American War. Students will study U.S. Presidents, the Victorian Age, Westward Expansion, and the Civil War. Students will be exposed to quality literature relevant to history as well as reading maps of historical locations.

### **Curriculum & Supplies:**

Homework will mostly consist of reading but may also include additional worksheets or small projects.
