Class Description:

We will focus on Year 4 of the Tapestry of Grace Curriculum beginning with the start of the twentieth century and ending with present-day events. Students will study U.S. Presidents, wars, and the highs and lows of American society in age-appropriate ways. Students will be exposed to quality literature relevant to history, as well as practice map skills of historical locations.

Curriculum & Supplies:

The Tapestry of Grace Lower Grammar Full-rack will be required for all students. A supply list and complete list of history and literature books will be emailed to parents by May 1.

Supplies needed:

Tests, Assignments, & Grades:

Students will complete age-appropriate projects during the course of the year. These may be cumulative or a presentation on a specific topic. Homework will include small assignments to reinforce learning from class and will include additional reading.
