Course Description

Building upon the principles taught in Saxon Math 6/5, Saxon 7/6 introduces functions and coordinate graphing, integers, exponential expressions, and prime factorization. Students will specifically learn about the order of operations, number lines, decimal place value, how to find the percent of a number, how to round decimal numbers, all operations with fractions, and more. Lessons contain a warm-up (with facts practice, mental math, & problem-solving exercises); introduction to the new concept, lesson practice exercises where the new skill is practiced, and mixed practice exercises, which includes a mixture of 25-30 old and new problems.

Course Requirements or Prerequisites

Completion of 6th grade math and BHC placement test.

Student Responsibilities:

Students are expected to be prepared for class each day and respectful to everyone. Class participation is both encouraged and expected. Tests will be given in class unless otherwise directed. All homework must be completed and uploaded to Google Classroom on time to receive full credit.

Tests and Grades

Final grades include homework (10%), class participation (10%), graded assignments (20%), and tests (60%).
