

Testing Tips and Reminders

H.E.R.I. testing is just around the corner so here's some last minute tips and reminders.

*Students should be well rested the week before testing; especially the night before. A tired student will have difficulty focusing and/or handling the demands of a test.

*Give your student a well-rounded breakfast. A healthy breakfast really does make the mind alert.

*On the drive to the testing site, encourage your student. Feeling good about themselves will help them do their best. Be relaxed.

*Please arrive on time. It's best to arrive at **8:45** so the student will not feel rushed.

*Provide a book to read if they finish testing early.

*All phones are to be turned off while in the classroom. All electronic handheld games and calculators are not allowed in the classroom.

*When you arrive at the testing site, locate the grade lists and confirm your student's information. Next, locate the flag of your student's grade and wait for announcements and their teacher.

*There will be an information table in the "Family Waiting Area" for questions and concerns. Parents of 1st and 2nd graders are asked to stay on site in the event a child or teacher needs them. If you are unable to stay, please advise a volunteer at the info desk and leave a contact number.
