How does it work?

1. Visit our website - Lebanonareahomeschoolers.com - and pay your annual family fee of \$20 due in July.
2. Once you have paid your family fee you can now contact the department heads of the activities in which you would like to participate. (see above list)
3. Each department will have information and costs associated with each activity.

Who can be in Shared Learning?

Families who have paid their lebanonareahomeschoolers.com family fee may join Shared Learning. We offer enrollment for Nursery to 18 year old Seniors!

When and where is Shared Learning?

Shared Learning meets at the First Freewill Baptist Church - 280 N. Vanburen Ave, in Lebanon, MO for 6 classes each semester. The 1st and 3rd Thursdays of September, October, and November for the Fall Semester. The 1st and 3rd Thursdays of March, April, and May for the Spring Semester. We hold 3 class hours, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.. Opening family meeting at 8:45 a.m.

What is the cost of participating?

We charge a fee of \$25 per family each semester to cover overhead costs like facility rent and insurance. Certain classes will have a fee to cover costs of class supplies.

Is Shared Learning a drop off program?

No, Shared Learning is a cooperative effort of homeschooling parents coming together to share our knowledge and abilities for the benefit of our children. Shared Learning is a family event - we have a nursery for babies and classes available for all age ranges to 18. A parent is required to stay on-site during the classes.

So, how does this work?

We invite parents to teach classes that match their particular interests and skills. Enrollment is first-come, first-served basis. Shared Learning builds the schedule based on teachers' class requests and the facility's space. Once the schedule is final, teachers get first opportunity to enroll their children.

Parents who are not teaching are required to assist 2 hours and are able to enroll after the teachers' families in the class seats remaining. Teachers will also be required to assist in one class.
