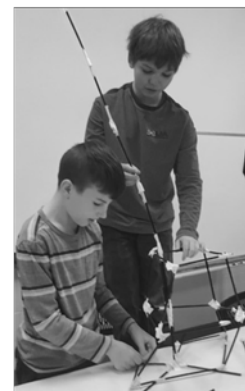
Firmly Planted Classical Community

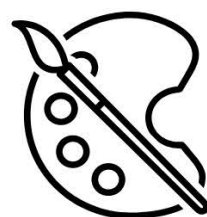
