These safety rules must be read to each person in your party

before going to any activities

Rules #1 Minors MUST always be accompanied by an adult!

This is a real working and playing ranch. Tell us immediately if you see anything dangerous, or that needs immediate attention.

Unlimited visits to any activity, however, no saving space or cutting in line. Any activity may be closed at any time for construction,

safety, or other reasons.

Our first aid station is in the General Store.

#5 Please do not walk on or across train tracks.

If you have any questions, or need help with anything, ask an Oil Ranch Team Member. Our first concern is safety and our second is for

everyone to have fun.

ACTIVITIES FOR EVERYONE...

Cow Poke Pony Rides: For children 12 and under (NO ADULTS). (1) Children must be accompanied by an adult (2) Ponies are hand led by an Oil Ranch

Team Member (3) One rider at a time (4) Please, only Oil Ranch Team Members in pony arena.

Petting Zoo:

For all ages – everyone gets to go inside! Please Do Not Chase the Animals! Disinfect hands after playing with animals.

Dainy Bam:

An educational exhibit showcasing modern day milking procedures. This includes the process of taking the milk from the dairy to you.

An Oil Ranch Team Member will assist you in milking the cow. Be sure to Disinfect hands before and after.

Hay Bam/ Animal Bam: Play in the Hay Barn. Adults must always supervise children in this area. Caution: Allergic reactions to hay, peanuts and dust may cause medical problems and should be considered before entering. These items are stored in the Barn. Tour the side halls of the big

barn and visit the baby animals (some animals are seasonal). Please, do not pick up the baby animals

Tumbleweed Racers: Take a roll in our giant Tumbleweed Wheel. No more than 2 people in each wheel. See if you can make it turn like a tumbleweed. Be

mindful of those outside the wheel. Do not stand in front or behind the wheel. Do not push from the outside.

Kid Hopper:

An in-ground jumping pillow. Shoes, watches, and jewelry must be removed. Socks are recommended while jumping. Must be

physically fit, no somersaults & absolutely no jumping when Oil Ranch Team Member is not present. No Jumping when wet.

Hayride:

Hand feed the cattle in the pasture. Do not get off the wagon without the permission of the driver. Caution: If you are pregnant or have medical problems; the hayride is very bumpy. Remember to be polite and form a line. No cutting in line or holding someone's

place in line.

Train Ride:

Board the Oil Ranch Express Railroad by the Windmill. Riders must always stay seated and keep arms and legs inside the train. Please

be polite and form a line. No cutting or holding someone's place in line. PLEASE do not walk on or across train tracks.

Spring Creek

Panning for fossils and gemstones is fun for all ages!!! You can purchase the mining rough at the Spring Creek Mining Station or at the General Store.

Mining:

All ages welcome with adult supervision. Target shooting only. Goggles must always be worn in Gallery. Paintball tickets are for sale at the General Store.

Gallery:

Shooting

Located next to the Frontier Village. Walk through the stockyard maze and see if you recognize the six flags over Texas.

Stockyard Maze:

Explore and play among the Teepees, Totem Pole, the Sky Swing, and Charlotte's Web.

Frontier Village:

Please observe posted safety rules. Balls and clubs provided. Please return them before leaving area.

Putt Putt:

Wild West

Playgrounds: Do not let ANY child do anything dangerous, your child or not. Swings, Slides, Softball, Soccer, Volleyball, Basketball, Tug-O-War,

Sack Races, Horseshoes are activities located around the ranch.

Fun Fishing:

Fun for the whole family! Catch and release fishing. Bring your own bait, tackle and pole.

Swimming:

Seasonal. No lifeguard on duty. Our Swimming pool is for everyone. All children must always be supervised by an adult. Bring

swimsuit & towel. No regular clothes allowed in pool.

Paddle Boats:

Waiver must be signed. One rider must be at least 18 years of age with a government issued photo ID. Up to 4 riders per boat. Children

must be able to sit on their own. All riders must wear a life vest. No swimming or fishing allowed from paddle boats.

Other Info:

(1) Lunches may be eaten at a pavilion (if not reserved). Weekdays only.

(2) Wagons may be used 10 minutes free or can be rented for the day for \$5.00. Please return wagons to front gate after using.

(3) Drinking fountains are located by the lake restroom facility.
